

## RECIPES FOR A PEACEFUL CULTURE #2 - SNOW ART

**Inspired by members of PeaceQuest Regina, engage your community with some impromptu temporary art! We designed these instructions to work with a group of 3.**

- 1.** Choose a good space of open snow in a public place. We find large slopes facing a path or roadway are the best. Depending on your physical ability, don't choose one too steep! Plan in advance the best "entry point" or spot close to the edge of your design where you may be able to take a giant step to your starting point.
- 2.** Stomp out a circle. Depending on your location, you may choose to have one of you be the "master artist" and direct the stompers from afar via speaking if you are close, or by mobile phone if you are far!
- 3.** When you get to the bottom of the circle, one of you will go one way and one the other, restomping the circle but stopping  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the way along the edge. Then you will turn and face each other and walk from this point on the outside to meet each other  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the way up the middle dividing line.
- 4.** Get out of the circle by walking carefully along the footprints you have made. If you are really lucky and have planned in advance, a hovering helicopter will lift you up and out, leaving your design mysteriously perfect! =)
- 5.** Was that easy? Feel free to come up with more ambitious words and images to share!
