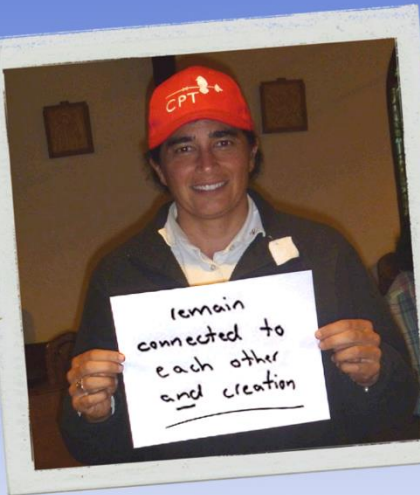


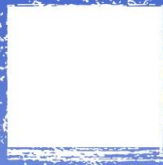

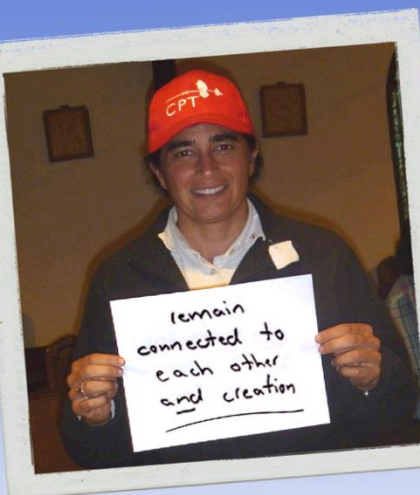

**1. Create your big white square** on which participants may write their answers. We recommend a small white board to save paper - but paper is OK too.

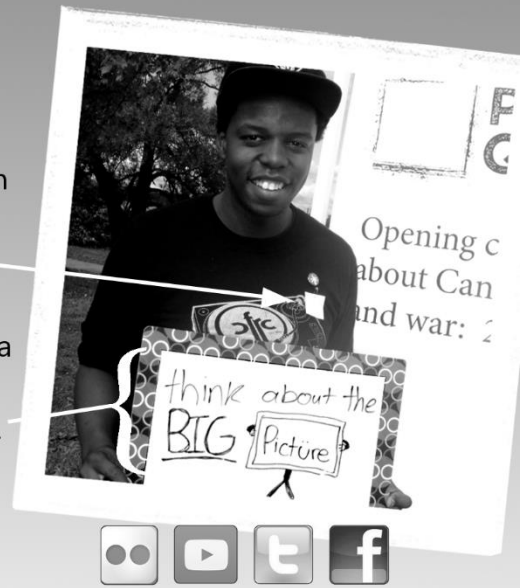
