“The Green Fields of Home” or “No Man’s Land” or “Willie McBride” by Eric Bogle

This song was written in 1976 by Eric Bogle, a Scottish-Australian song writer, inspired by the grave of a young soldier who was killed in WW I at the age of 19. The chorus refers to The Last Post and The Flowers of the Forest, two famous pieces of military music.
